

Yacht Rental Terms and Conditions:

1. The rental agreement is between Top Catamaran Charter and the client.
2. The rental fee includes the use of the yacht and its equipment for the agreed rental period.
3. The rental period starts and ends at the times and dates agreed upon by both parties.
4. The client is responsible for any damage caused to the yacht or its equipment during the rental period.
5. A security deposit is required at the start of the rental period. In case of damages to the vessel within the rental period, charterer will be charged from security deposit.
6. Top Catamaran Charter offers deposit insurance to protect clients in case of damages.
7. The client must have a valid sailing license and provide proof of experience if requested.
8. The client must comply with all local laws and regulations.
9. Top Catamaran Charter reserves the right to cancel the rental agreement if the client fails to comply with the terms and conditions.
10. The client is responsible for all costs associated with fuel, provisions, and other expenses incurred during the rental period.
11. The client must return the yacht in the same condition as received.
12. In case of early return of the yacht, no refund will be issued.
13. Top Catamaran Charter is not liable for any personal injury or property damage incurred during the rental period.
14. a, Terms and conditions in case of cancellation:
 - Cost of cancellation:
 - More than 120 days prior to departure: 500 Euros
 - Between 120 and 60 days prior to departure: 50% of the charter price
 - 59 days or less of departure: 100% of the price of the charter

14.b, Terms and conditions in case of postpone :

We can offer postpone your charter only if the departure is in more than 90 days, fully paid and we will charge 500 € as application fees.

15. Night navigation is not allowed, and the sailing area is limited to the Inner islands of the Seychelles.

Should the chartered vessel be taken outside of this area without written consent from TOP CATAMARAN CHARTER, the charterer will be liable for any financial and legal implications.

The charterer acknowledges that he/she read and accept the general terms and condition of the rental agreement.
